From Director's Desk





About Convocation Complex

The University Convocation Complex is a perfect venue for your next event: seminar, symposium, conference, workshop or a theatre performance. It is beautifully designed and fitted with the state-of-the-art light and sound equipment to meet the requirements of our clients ranging from educational institutions to non-governmental organizations to government departments and media and business houses. The acoustically sound auditorium, with a seating capacity of over 2000 persons in its main hall and balcony, is located conveniently inside the picturesque campus of the University of Kashmir—12 Kms from the City Centre. The auditorium has a large wooden stage, a well-furnished VIP Lounge, comfortable pushback chairs and is both centrally heated and air-conditioned.

Facilities

The Convocation Complex is equipped with state-of-the-art facilities apt for holding different events.

- The light equipments available include moving heads, scanners, strobos, cyclorama, power cans, baby spots, halogen lights which give a distinct appearance to the main hall and the stage, depending upon the nature of the function and requirements of our clients.
- The auditorium is has three display spots on its left, right and back side where projectors are focused for screening of films, multimedia presentations, slideshows and display of graphics.
- The wooden floor of the stage is fitted with highly professional XLR audio ports and electric points. The background of the stage is a white 50x15 ft screen used for display of graphics and screening of films and documentaries.
- A spacious backstage is available for rehearsal purposes for theatre performances and cultural programs.




Seperate space for Catering

Allied facilities

- **VIP LOUNGE:**The auditorium has a well-furnished comfortable VIP Lounge, which is centrally heated and air-conditioned. A separate entrance leads to the spacious Lounge.
- **LOBBIES:** The Complex has two spacious atrium lobbies, used for exhibition purposes and establishment of stalls and kiosks.
- **CATERING:**The ground floor lobby as a separate space for catering for VIPs, fitted with 54 inch LCD Screens.
- **PARKING SPACE:** The Complex has a separate parking space for both VIPs and other delegates, accommodating about 500 vehicles.
- **FIREPROOF:** The Complex is fireproof and due care has been taken for the overall safety of visitors.
- **DRESSING ROOMS:** The Complex has two conveniently located dressing rooms on left and right side of the stage apart from six washroom blocks in its two storeys.
- **UNINTERRUPTED POWER SUPPLY:** The Complex is powered by two 400 KV Gensets for uninterrupted power supply and use of boiler and chiller for heating and air-condition purposes.
- **INTERNET FACILITY:** Internet, printing and scanning facility is available in the Complex.
